Thank you for all your support during the year. Please read through the meeting minutes that are included in this newsletter.

Notice of Bylaw Change Proposal

The ByLaws committee was approached by members of the Gateway and South Region with a request to consolidate their Regions with the Mississippi Valley Region. This would be similar to the consolidation of the Southeast, River Valley and East Regions into the SERVE region several years ago. The ByLaw committee put together the proposed ByLaws changes to combine the Gateway, Mississippi Valley and South Regions to become the single South by Southwest Region.

The proposed change would remove Article III Section 2 Subsections D, E, and I to be replaced by the new Subsection below for the South by Southwest Region as Subsection G. Subsequently, for housekeeping purposes, subsection F would become subsection D, subsection G would become subsection E, subsection H would become subsection F, and subsection J would become subsection H. That would keep D - H alphabetical.

G. South by Southwest Region. The counties of Bond, Madison, and Montgomery (excluding the community of Nokomis which shall be in the SERVE Region), Clinton, St. Clair, Washington, Macoupin County (the community of Mount Olive only), Monroe, Randolph, Washington, Wayne, Marion, Edwards, Wabash, Jefferson, Perry, Franklin, Hamilton, White, Jackson, Williamson, Saline, Gallatin, Union, Johnson, Pope, Hardin, Alexander, Pulaski, and Massac.

The ByLaws committee would also propose an additional change to Article III Section 2 requested by Active members residing in Kankakee County. With this change, Kankakee County will be moved for inclusion in the SERVE Region to being included as part of the Northeast Region.

Geographically, Kankakee County is adjacent to the Northeast Region and closer to that region than the majority of active SERVE Region members. Kankakee County is also included with the Northeast as part of Region 3 with the IL Jaycees. This change has been discussed with and agreed to by both of those Regions.
